<b>Post-9/11 GI Bill® (Chapter 33)</b>
<b>Eligible individuals receive a percentage of the following, based on length of service.</b>
<b>Tuition and Fees</b> Payments are issued to the school. VA pays the actual net cost for in-state tuition and fees for up to 36 months.
<b>Housing Allowance</b> The payment is issued to the student at the beginning of each month for training pursued the previous month. Active duty personnel and students pursuing training at the rate of 50% or less are not eligible. <b>Book and Supply Stipend</b> This payment is issued to the student, based on the number of credit or clock hours certified by the school, not to exceed \$1,000.00 per year. The rate is \$41.67 per credit hour. For programs measured in clock hours, VA will pay \$83.00/month (prorated for partial months).

**Effective September 5, 2014, the Department of Defense (DoD) implemented the following policy:**

Tuition Assistance (TA) is no longer authorized for classes for which a member is also receiving Veteran Affairs benefits under the Montgomery GI Bill-Selected Reserve (MGIB-SR/Chapter 1606) or Reserve Educational Assistance Program (REAP/Chapter 1607). TA and VA benefits may be used during the semester, but cannot be used to pay for the same class.
