My Career Advancement Account (MyCAA) Scholarship

My Career Advancement Account (MyCAA) Scholarship Program, a component of the Department of Defense (DoD) Spouse Education and Career Opportunities (SECO) program, is a career development and employment assistance program. MyCAA helps military spouses, who have successfully completed high school, pursue licenses, credentials, or associate degrees with a specific concentration or major to pursue an occupation or career with transferable and portable skills.

MyCAA provides a max. tuition benefit of \$4,000 with an annual fiscal year (Oct. 1 – Sept. 30) cap of \$2,000 to assist eligible military spouses who need professional credentials to meet their portable career goals. MyCAA does not pay for fees including, but not limited to, registration fees, technology fees, and parking fees.

Spouses can visit the MyCAA Spouse Portal online at <https://aiportal.acc.af.mil/mycaa> and provide the required Spouse Profile information. A real-time Defense Enrollment Eligibility Reporting System (DEERS) eligibility check will confirm if spouses meet MyCAA eligibility requirements. Once confirmed, spouses can move forward and establish a MyCAA Account. Getting Started is Easy!

1. Follow instructions to [Log in or Register](#)
2. Establish MyICP with SECO
3. Create a career goal in your MyCAA account
4. **Contact your school Academic Advisor and ask them to create an Education & Training Plan (ETP). Submit your ETP to your MyCAA account.**
5. Request Financial Assistance (FA) for every course of study
 1. Request FA within 60 days before the start date of the course
 2. FA requests **must be submitted ONE DAY before** the term start date
 3. FA is **invoiced** after the Last Day to Drop a Class (Census Date)
