

## **State Tuition Assistance (STA)**

The New Mexico National Guard Tuition Scholarship Program (NMNGTSP) is commonly known as State Tuition Assistance (STA). The scholarship provides eligible members of the New Mexico National Guard an opportunity to complete <u>up to a bachelor's degree</u>. STA is paid directly to the school and is invoiced after the term's Last Day to Drop a Class without a W grade (100% refund). The <u>Air National Guard</u> yearly cap is \$8,000. The <u>Army National Guard</u> yearly cap is \$4,000. The STA fiscal year is from July 1 – June 30.

## **State Tuition Assistance Deadlines:**

Fall Semester – July 15th Spring Semester – December 1st Summer Semester – May 1st
