

Student Veteran Housing

New Mexico State University is one of the first in the nation to offer on-campus housing specifically designated for student veterans and their families transitioning out of the military and into student life. The Department of Housing & Residential Life has worked in conjunction with the Student Veterans Organization of NMSU to offer affordable housing on campus to student veterans attending the university. A designated portion of Tom Fort Village in Student Family Housing will be set aside to create the student veteran community.



TOM FORT AND SUTHERLAND VILLAGES

Tom Fort and Sutherland Villages flourish with activity as children play in front yards and neighbors barbecue together. These unfurnished, 2-bedroom, one-story homes are a favorite among our veterans and feature large fenced-in yards where approved pets are welcome. The Tom Fort and Sutherland Villages are \$6443 (billed per academic year). Rate includes all utilities, cable TV, and high-speed Internet.

Tom Fort and Sutherland Villages are available for student veterans. Located approximately half a mile from the heart of campus, these homes are walking distance from the DACC campus, library, James B. Delamater Activity Center, Aquatic Center, and many other buildings on campus.

AGGIE EXPRESS COMMUNITY CENTER

The Aggie Express Community Center is only steps away from the Tom Fort and Sutherland Villages (located at the corner of Williams Avenue and Standley Drive). The community center features a community-size laundry with front load washers and dryers, a large computer lab, and a fitness center. Additionally, the Aggie Express store stocks a broad selection of food items and daily needs.

APPLICATION

Interested student veterans need to complete a housing application at Housing & Residential Life Office. The Housing & Residential Life Office is open Monday through Friday, from 8 am-5pm. A veteran status identification and picture ID are also required at the time of application.
